About the Aranui 5: This new vessel offers a selection of accommodations for 254 passengers ranging from spacious suites with private balconies to economical dormitory style shared cabins. There are 30 Suites and 28 Deluxe and Superior Deluxe Staterooms with balconies; two Junior Suites and three Superior Deluxe without balconies; and 40 Standard Staterooms, all of which have private facilities, private safes, and air-conditioning. The ship, in addition to an outdoor swimming pool and dining room, has two lounges, two bars, a library, and special marine facilities for fishing, snorkeling, and scuba diving. The dining room menu features French and Polynesian cuisine with complimentary table wine for lunch and dinner. French registry.

Departure, Ports-Of-Call: The *Aranui* departs Papeete, Tahiti for Takapoto (Tuamotu), Nuku Hiva, Ua Pou, Tahuata, Fatu Hiva, Hiva Oa, Ua Huka, Nuku Hiva, Rangiroa, and Bora Bora returning to Papeete. 14 days.

Prices effective for the new vessel, Aranui 5 include 3 meals with complimentary wine, guided excursions, picnic and meals on shore. Optional excursion such as scuba diving, horseback riding, fishing and helicopter tours are not included.

Children tariff: 50% of base tariff

Triple Occupancy - third adult sharing cabin less 25% from full tariff

Quadruple occupancy - third & fourth adult sharing cabin less 25% from full tariff (available in stateroom only)

Single occupancy in a double cabin: add 50% surcharge

Single occupancy in a single cabin: add 40% surcharge (available in regular stateroom only)

No one under 15 years old will be accepted in Class "C"

Children (14 years old and under) will be limited to no more than 15 per sailing

Rates include accommodations, three meals per day with complimentary wine and shore excursions.

Deposit and Payment: 25% deposit is required at the time of confirmation. Full payment is due 45 days prior to departure.

Visa: Visitors to the French Overseas Territory of French Polynesia are required to obtain a visa only if staying 30 days or longer. This visa must be applied for in person at a French Consulate due to regulations effective June 2005.

Cancellations: The following cancellation fees will be applied by CPTM: If cancelled after confirmation of space but more than 60 days prior to departure—\$75 per person. Additionally, Air/Sea reservations are subject to a \$75 cancellation fee. If cancelled 60 to 45 days before scheduled departure date—1/3 of the total fare. If cancelled 44 to 30 days before scheduled departure date—2/3 of the total fare. If cancelled less than 30 days and non-appearance at cruise departure date—the total fare will be retained. Changes to the confirmed departure date less than 60 days prior to the confirmed departure date will be subject to the same penalties as cancellations. Air rates and air taxes subject to change without notice. "Air fare, once paid in full, is subject to penalty and may be non-refundable." **Health and Age Restrictions:** There is a doctor aboard the *Aranui*; however, if any person has or is suffering from a serious ailment or condition, they should seek the advice and consent of their personal physician prior to embarkation. There is no age limit, but agility is very important to enjoy this trip. **Additional comments:** Prospective passengers should realize the *Aranui* is a cargo ship and not a luxury cruise vessel. Nearly all visits to islands will be made by tendering to the beach with the assistance of the crew. All meals are served in an informal, family style. Self-service laundry facilities are onboard for passenger use, but dry cleaning is not available.
